In recent years there has been a significant increase in the number of family violence cases, mental health issues, youth unemployment and homelessness in the City of Whittlesea. With tremendous pressure on existing community service organisations, families are being pushed to the edge. In the lead up to the November State election, Whittlesea Community Futures, a collaborative network of 45 local agencies, have united to secure commitments from state politicians to improve a shortfall in critical services for families, children and young people.
